

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS (VEHICLE FERRIES)

BEHAVIOUR	EXAMPLES OF HOW TO MEET THE CODE
Respect other people and property	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Treat other people and their possessions with respect. • Follow the crew's directions without argument. • Do not interfere with vessel property, equipment, and signs by marking or damaging them in any way.
Wait for the vessel in an orderly manner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wait at the top of the ramp until a member of Stradbroke Ferries staff issues boarding instructions. • Stand quietly without calling out or shouting.
Whilst on the vessel conduct yourself in an orderly manner	<p>Players must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • always follow instructions from the crew about safety on the vessel • remain in your designated area as instructed by your team officials and/or Stradbroke Ferries staff. • Obtain permission from your team officials to visit the café. • speak quietly and not create unnecessary noise <p>Players must not:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • bully other passengers • place feet on the seats • fight, spit or use offensive language • throw any article around or from the vessel • smoke (prohibited on all ferries) • allow any portion of their body to protrude over the vessel rails or out of the vessel windows
When alighting from the vessel, do so in an orderly manner.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wait on board at designated area with team officials until instruction to disembark by Stradbroke Ferries staff.. • Alight from the vessel in a quiet and orderly fashion.
In case of an emergency or a breakdown, follow the crew's directions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wait in the area indicated by the crew.
